Aviation High School Bring Your Own iPad (BYO iPad) User Agreement

Aviation High School has a Bring Your Own iPad (BYO iPad) program for all students enrolled in Years 7 and 8. For the BYO iPad program to successfully support teaching and learning in the Aviation High context it is important that parents /careers and students agree to the following conditions:

- That only a device listed in the “Acceptable devices list” is permitted to be used in the Aviation High School High School BYO iPad program. Aviation High School has selected the devices published in the “Acceptable Devices List” as those most suitable for the Aviation High School teaching and learning context.
- That the Apps published in the “Aviation High School Apps list” should be purchased and installed on the device prior to the beginning of the school year. The school retains the right to add additional apps to the apps list as deemed necessary for classroom outcomes.
- That all damages, breakages, loss and theft are the responsibility of the owner of the device. Students are encouraged to store their iPads in their lockers when not being used in class. Parents are encouraged to take out appropriate insurance for the device. Any damage, breakages, loss and theft should be reported to the school.
- That the device while in the school is used for appropriate educational activities at the discretion of the teacher. In accordance with the BYO iPad Policy and Procedures:
 - Teachers can at their discretion temporarily confiscate the device from the students.
 - For repeat offenders the device can be confiscated by a HOD, DP or Principal and stored securely in the Front Office. Parents may retrieve the device at any time during office hours. Students will have access the next school day.
 - At the discretion of the Principal, DP or HOD IT the school may apply an extended ban to the use of the device at school.
 - At the discretion of the Principal the student may be banned permanently for confirmed inappropriate use of the device or for such use that brings the school into disrepute.
- That if the device has cellular capabilities parents retain responsibility for how the device is used. Parents are advised to remove the sim card to disable cellular capabilities during the school day.
- Parents/Careers and students must present the BYO iPad and access passwords to the Principal, Deputy Principal or HOD IT when instructed to facilitate investigation of any alleged, or otherwise, misuse of the BYO iPad in the school environment.
- Students of Parents/Careers that do not agree to this user agreement will not be able to bring a device to school for use in the Aviation High School BYO iPad program.
- Students must ensure that the device is stored securely in their lockers while not in use at school.

Classroom 2.0 App

The App brings with it some great features that will further transform how teachers and students interact in their digital classroom. It turns the teachers iPad into a powerful teaching assistant, helping a teacher guide student's through a lesson, see their progress, and keep them on track.

Classroom 2.0 helps teachers focus on teaching so students can focus on learning.

Some of the other key features of Classroom 2.0 will allow teachers to:

- Launch any app, website, or book on student devices with a tap
- Lock devices into a single app to help students focus
- See an overview of all student screens at once
- Showcase the great work individual students are doing to the class
- Share documents and links to and from student devices

Classroom 2.0 App Settings

- Students must ensure that the Classroom App has the below setting enabled:
 - Join Classes – **“Automatically”**
 - Lock Apps and Device – **“Always”**
 - Airplay and View Screen set to – **“Always”**

AirDrop during class time

Students will only use the AirDrop feature during curriculum time at direction of the teacher.

Failure of students to follow the above conditions will result in Teachers, Heads of Departments, Deputies and the Principal applying the consequences in accordance with the schools responsible behaviour plan.
